



BRITISH DODGEBALL NATIONAL TEAM

TRANSFER POLICY

Although we hope that transfers between international teams are rare we do understand that because of the nature of circumstances and in particular our unique environment as home nations being part of the United Kingdom that transfer requests between National Teams do happen. The following transfer policy must be adhered to and completed in full prior to any player completing a National Team transfer.

No player is permitted to transfer between national teams more than once. Any player that has already transferred between two Home Nations Teams is not permitted to transfer again. For further information on eligibility of transfer please refer to the [EDF Eligibility Requirements](#).

Process

1. Nation player wishing to transfer to must submit a transfer request via email to the British Dodgeball Board via their management committee British Dodgeball representative. Transfer request must include statement from the player with reasoning.
2. Approval of the transfer is received from both National Team Management Committees involved.
3. British Dodgeball board will contact player to ensure they understand the implications of their transfer.
4. British Dodgeball approves/does not approve and communicates decision to player and National Team Managers.
5. If transfer approved by British Dodgeball this is communicated to the European Dodgeball Federation.
