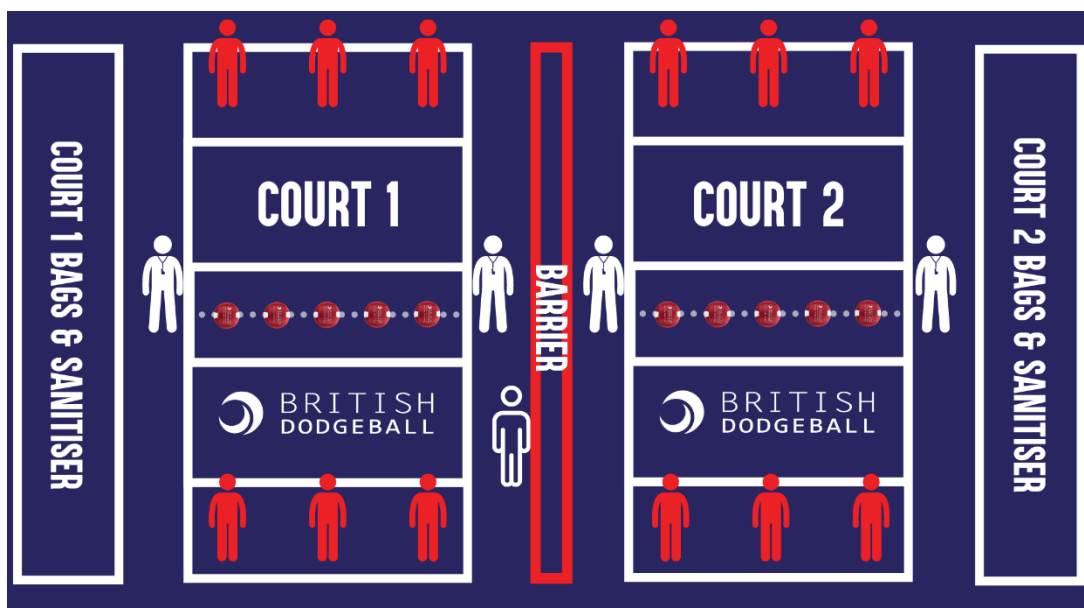

## COURSE UPDATES

Coach education is classed as 'Education & Training', which is exempt from the 'rule of 6'. This means our coach education can continue for adults as well as young people. We have however adapted the layout of our courses to place participants into smaller bubbles for the duration of a course where possible.

All previous guidance contained in the return to play guidelines and COVID-19 risk assessment regarding social distancing, the use of hand sanitiser and equipment transfer should still be followed on courses.



## COURSE LAYOUT

- Courses involving adults will have a maximum of 16 attendees per group. Courses involving children will have limits set by the organisation which hosts the course.
- For courses involving adults, the space will be split into 2 courts.
- Where possible, each court will have a maximum of 6 participants playing at any one time. A maximum of 2 participants per court will be coaching each court.
- On smaller courses (e.g. of 10 participants), only one court will be used. 2 or 3 participants will lead 7 or 8 participants through a session.
- Court 1 and 2 will have separate places to store bags and belongings in a socially-distanced manner. If possible and safe, a barrier will be put between the courts to limit interaction between both courts.
- For the adult Level 2 coaching course, there will be 4 groups on each court. Group 1 on court 1 and group 1 on court 2 will plan and lead activities independently, as will groups 2, 3 and 4.
- The tutor will remain socially distant at all times. When leading discussions, they will ensure both courts remain socially-distanced throughout.
