RETURN TO PLAY GUIDANCE ENGLAND

12th April:

Outdoor organised dodgeball is allowed

From 17th May:

Organised adult indoor group sport can return following NGB approved guidance

From 21st June:

Easing or restrictions/no restrictions (TBC)



RETURN TO PLAY GUIDANCE WALES

26th April: Outdoor organised dodgeball is allowed

3rd May: Indoor sessions for up to 15 adults

SCOTLAND

All Levels: Outdoor organised dodgeball is allowed

At Level 2: Indoor organised dodgeball is allowed

NORTHERN IRELAND

23rd April: Outdoor organised dodgeball is allowed

From 24th May: NI Executive hopes for Indoor sessions to resume w/limited numbers

Regional League Entry

- Please state the number of teams you wish to enter and your preferred location.
- Entry fees TBC with clubs to receive an invoice.

Open Event Entry

- Entry into all Open events will be made through British Dodgeball website and will require payment at that time.
- Entry will go live on 31/5/2021.

Events Safety & Layout

- Safety is our first priority, therefore open events may look different to previously.
- 1 person/100sqft limit (if in place) = 60 people in a standard hall,
 which is approx. 8 teams of 7 + event staff w/ no spectators.
- Next guidance update regarding limits will be important and will inform our competition regulations.





So far, we have 9 rounds for the English National League booked in at St Georges Park:

- 21st Nov 2021
- 4th Dec 2021
- 8th Jan 2022
- 15th Jan 2022

- 29th Jan 2022
- 2nd Apr 2022
- 23rd Apr 2022
- 14th May 2022

Irish and Scottish Leagues will hopefully be accommodated on the same weekends.

Rest of Calendar

- The remainder of the calendar will be populated with a mixture of regional leagues, Open events including Mixed Opens and a Foam series.
- The first Open of the season will be on the weekend of September 18th/19th.





English League Structure

- Our plan is still to have expanded Men's Super League and League 1 at SGP along with the Women's Super League and League 1.
- We intend to run North and South Leagues from League 2
 and below. This follows feedback from surveys and allows
 us to grow the sport out from SGP which is saturated.
- This plan is dependent on team entry and commitment from clubs based on previous levels.
- For forward planning purposes, there will be a League entry window throughout July. Clubs will need to commit to League entry by 31st July 2021 for the 2021-22 season.

Scottish and NI League Structure

- No major changes planned.
- Looking to recruit event coordinators in most regions.






Word of mouth (friends, colleagues)

Qualification Requirements

- By September 2021, all clubs must be led by at least one British Dodgeball Level 2
 Qualified Dodgeball coach. This individual will need specifying upon club membership
 renewal.
- Those with old qualifications may attend a Level 2 course at a discounted rate (50% off email hello@britishdodgeball.com to organise).
- Anyone with an old certificate who will be a <u>listed club coach</u> next year can access refresher training for free – email <u>hello@britishdodgeball.com</u> to organise.
- Any further requirements for clubs & individuals next season will be outlined in the near future.
- Online courses successful Introduction to Coaching Dodgeball relevant for players moving into coaching.
- Level 1 Award in Coaching Dodgeball online version is now out.
- The Level 1 will become a prerequisite for anyone wishing to attend a Level 2 course from September 2021.



Questions

Q: What if my club is owed money from entering cancelled events?

A: If you would like to enter an event and use payment credited from previously cancelled events, please email Gareth who will confirm and update the website. Please be aware of working hours for events in high demand.

Q: Can you play more than 6v6 Dodgeball?
A: Not currently for adults. Return to play document states: 6 a-side dodgeball can return as long as groups are limited to aid social distancing at the venue. Please check with your facility hirer.



Questions

Q: Can you have a team of 8 where only 6 will play at one time with the other 2 refereeing / retrieving.

A: The rule of 6 no longer applies so this is allowed.

Q: During the session, do you have to stick with the same 5 other players (team of 6)?

A: No. The rule of 6 no longer applies so you can mix groups up.
