Assessment Framework (Online versions)

Assessment Criteria

The British Dodgeball online workshops can be passed or failed via progress check quizzes and a final quiz. If a candidate fails, they have unlimited chances to retry until they have built up enough knowledge to pass.

Progress Checks & Final Quiz

Lessons consist of text, images, interactive elements and video content. There are progress text quizzes after a set number of lessons which test candidate's learning of the content and ability to apply knowledge in a contextual manner. Candidates must get a passing grade of 70% or more on each quiz to proceed through the course. These quizzes can be retaken if a candidate does not achieve the necessary grade.

Earning a Certificate

Once a candidate has demonstrated adequate understanding of the workshop content by passing all quizzes. They can access and download their certificate from the course page or their user profile on the British Dodgeball website.

Assessment Framework (Face to Face version)

Practical Assessment

Participants will have the opportunity to lead others during the course. Tutors will not formally assess each candidate's performance linked to strict assessment criteria, but will be on hand to offer guidance & advice.

Earning a Certificate

Once a candidate has attempted to lead others and taken learning on board during the course, they have completed the workshop and are eligible for certification. Candidates that do not properly engage with course content will not be eligible for certification and must retake the course in the future.

Certification

An E-certificate will be issued upon notification of completion. This will be available to view and download immediately on the course page for the online version of the workshop. For the face to face version, this will be sent out via email once notification has been given by the workshop tutor that the individual has completed the workshop and any outstanding invoices have been paid. Any participant waiting for a certificate that has completed the steps outlined above should wait for up to 10 working days before emailing hello@britishdodgeball.com with any enquiries.
